

## Having trouble Shopping for Rewards when you click on 'Shop Now' or 'Browse Only'?

This may be due to the following reasons:

**1.** You have your pop-up blocker on. When you click on either 'Shop Now' or 'Browse Only', it pops-up a new window. You may want to allow pop-ups for this site only. For instructions on how to do this, [click here](#).

**2.** It might actually be open, but the new screen is "hidden" behind the Aftermarket Rewards Web site. See that new window below titled "AwardslinQ Home" in the taskbar on the bottom of the computer monitor? Just click on it to bring that screen to the front so you can see all the wonderful rewards.





## Internet Explorer

If you have a new version of Internet Explorer, it comes with a pop up blocker. To change your settings select "tools" from the menu at the top, then "Pop Up Blocker", then "Pop Up Blocker Settings". There you can add Web sites to always allow pop ups or change the intensity of the pop up blocker. You may also click the following link to get more help with disabling your popup blocker.

## Firefox Browser

Select "Tools" from the menu at the top then "Options". Select the "Content" icon at the top of the window. Here you can turn off the pop up blocker or add allowed sites.



## Netscape 7.1

By default, the pop-up ad blocker is turned off. To enable it or change any settings:

1. Click on Edit
2. Click on Preferences
3. Click on Privacy & Security
4. Click on Pop-up windows
5. Check Block unrequested pop-up windows. Once this option is checked, then you will be able to "Allow sites," allow pop-ups from [www.AftermarketRewards.com](http://www.AftermarketRewards.com).

## Google Toolbar

When a pop up is blocked you will get a notification line towards the top of the window. Click it for options to allow the pop up one time or always allow them at that site. You may also try clicking on the words 'blocked' (circled above) and it will allow the new window to pop-up.

## Your ISP (Internet Service Provider)

Some Internet Service Providers such as AOL have pop up blocking ability built in. You will need to check the support/help files to determine how to bypass the pop up blocker.

## Pop Up Blocking Programs

If you are using a program that includes pop up blocking you will need to check the program documentation to find out how to adjust the settings. Just open the program and look for pop up blocking. If necessary, go to the help file and search for pop up blocking.

If you use a different browser, visit the help menu for specific instructions on allowing pop-ups.
